A Virginia National Guard Battalion, the 3rd Battalion 116th infantry, will join Shenandoah Valley Westminster-Canterbury to celebrate the 4th of July. The event will take place in the courtyard from 11am to 1pm. and **is free and open to the public.**

The Battalion, dressed in battle gear, will set up its demonstration with two or three Humvee military vehicles in the parking area near the courtyard gazebo.
