Shenandoah Valley Westminster-Canterbury will hold a chapel groundbreaking celebration and reception on Tuesday, July 28 at 2 p.m. In addition to SVWC CEO, Jeannie Shiley and Board Chairman, Dr. Terry Sinclair, **Senator Jill Holtzman Vogel** will be participating in the groundbreaking festivities.

The plan to build a chapel at Shenandoah Valley Westminster-Canterbury was conceived in 2006 and following a successful capital campaign in 2007 and 2008 solid plans were drawn up for the chapel construction. When completed (November 2009) the chapel will seat 90 people and be a dedicated place for worship, education, reflection and meditation for people of all faiths and traditions.

Currently the SVWC community offers a Sunday worship service and three local churches come monthly to hold communion services: Christ Episcopal Church, First Presbyterian Church and Sacred Heart of Jesus. Special holy day services, memorial services and Bible studies are also held regularly.
